

The Ocean Nova

The Expedition Ship Ocean Nova was built in Denmark in 1992 and is designed to carry travelers in comfort and safety to the most remote corners of the mostly frozen world.

The ship was fully refurbished in 2006 and has since benefitted from annual upgrades and improvements. Her ice-strengthened hull and small size are ideally suited for intimate & up-close expedition travel in Antarctica and in the Arctic.

The ship can accommodate up to 72 passengers (78 in the Arctic) in small but comfortable, all en-suite, outside cabins. The ship offers dedicated single, twin and some triple cabins (party of 3 must book together). The single cabins have a one lower bed, the twins two lower beds and the triples two lower and an upper bed; all cabins feature a large porthole or window, writing desk & chair.

The very generously sized glassed-in observation deck and the cozy library both offer excellent views of the surroundings. In addition there is the dining room, a bar, a small gym (with windows) and a clinic with a medical doctor and basic supplies. The ship has 7 zodiacs and depending on the voyage, offers optional adventures such as sea-kayaking and hiking/snow-shoeing.
